

Dear Alumni and Friends,

On behalf of the Farmingdale College Foundation and the Farmingdale College Alumni Association, thank you for supporting this year's in-person President's Gala.

Time and time again throughout Farmingdale's long history, we have proven how the College emerges stronger after facing adversity. The same is true now, in 2021, as our students continue to excel academically and our graduates routinely find success early on in their careers. In fact, according to the College Net Social Mobility Index they are ranked in the top 2% nationally in early career earnings.

Our most remarkable stories revolve around our students who are job ready when they graduate from FSC; 94% of them are employed six months after graduation or enrolled in graduate school. The majority of recent graduates stay close to home with 96% of them working in New York State, 95% in New York City and 75% on Long Island.

Many of these graduates leave Farmingdale with little or no debt. FSC ranks #4 among New York State public colleges in lowest student debt and 55% of bachelor's students graduate with no debt.

For more than a century, over 100,000 Farmingdale State College alumni have been the fuel for the Long Island economy. As the College embraces the future with great enthusiasm, we look forward to working with even more corporate partners, alumni and friends to create new pathways to success.

The Ram's Horn Award for Corporate Leadership



The Ram's Horn Award for Corporate Leadership VINCENT TEDESCO

President and CEO, Total Technology Solutions

An industry leader and 33-year IT veteran, Vincent Tedesco founded Total Technology Solutions in 1988 in Melville, New York. He transformed a computer VAR into a leading full-service Information Technology solutions provider. With vision and leadership, the organization evolved with the changing IT industry to provide innovative solutions for business continuity and cybersecurity. Total Technology Solutions offers a broad

range of IT services from ensuring day-to-day business continuity to diagnosing and defusing potentially hazardous IT threats.

In an initiative to combat cybersecurity threats, Mr. Tedesco formed an internal Security-as-a-Service Committee. The committee reviews cybersecurity tools and services and researches newly reported vulnerabilities issued by the National Institute of Standards and Technology's (NIST) National Vulnerability Database (NVD).

Mr. Tedesco was instrumental in the development of a public safety software application that has since been acquired by two industry leading public safety software vendors, Tiburon, Inc. then TriTech Software Systems. He was also named COO at Tiburon, Inc.

Today, Mr. Tedesco is a member of the International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP). In addition, he is a Farmingdale College Foundation Board Member and his son is a senior and soccer player at Farmingdale State College. A true family man, Mr. Tedesco enjoys spending quality time with his wife and three college-aged children.



The President's Award for Alumni Leadership



The President's Award for Alumni Leadership MURRAY PASTERNACK '60

Founder and CEO (retired), Pasternack Enterprises

Even before enrolling at FSC, Murray Pasternack '60 had developed a keen interest in radio frequency (RF) components — the modules that transmit signals and are most often used in everyday consumer products such as microwaves, garage door openers, and wireless alarm systems. That passion propelled him to spectacular success in the RF industry and, most recently, to the status of one of Farmingdale's largest alumni benefactors.

Fast forward, Mr. Pasternack is now a retired Attorney, Engineer, Banker, Entrepreneur and Private Equity Investor. His first career was an electronic engineer where he spent ten years working for world class aerospace companies designing complex microwave receiver components. In 1962 he founded Electro-Physics Corporation of America, aka EPCOA, and has operated it and its successors ever since. Among his designs were the mono-pulse radar receiver for the Gemini space program used in 1965 to accomplish the very first rendezvous in orbit and a transceiver used by downed US Navy pilots to communicate with rescuers during the Vietnam War. In 1970, he founded Southwest Microwave Company (not related to the current company of the same name), a microwave components manufacturer and co-founded Environmental Communications, Inc., a company that developed one of the earliest cable television audience response systems.

In 1972, after selling his interest in both companies, he founded Pasternack Enterprises (see www.pasternack.com). Under his leadership, Pasternack Enterprises became a world class supplier of radio frequency and microwave components. Mr. Pasternack studied law while also managing Pasternack Enterprises and in 1976 passed the California Bar Exam. Mr. Pasternack practiced law from 1976 until 2020. His law practice was limited to business related law. Mr. Pasternack managed Pasternack Enterprises as President and sole owner for more than twenty years before turning the company over to his son. Mr. Pasternack has in addition to practicing law, consulted to and/or invested in dozens of small and medium size businesses. Mr. Pasternack was, for 10 years, a founder, director and the controlling stockholder of Capital Bank, now a part of Enterprise Financial Services Corporation, with bank branches in 6 states. Mr. Pasternack received his Associates Degree at Farmingdale where he studied Electrical Technology, followed by his Bachelors and Juris Doctor degrees at the American College of Law.

Since re-connecting with FSC, recently Mr. Pasternack has committed a total 1 Million Dollars to fund the Murray Pasternack Endowed Scholarship in Engineering.

Professor, Visual Communications Department

An educator, administrator, and accomplished freelance designer, illustrator, and entrepreneur, Allison Puff has contributed a great deal to Farmingdale State College and to the community at large. Currently the Academic Program Manager, she has helped faculty across the College develop sixteen new programs and revise fourteen. She has also

served as Associate Provost, Associate Dean of the School of Business, and Chair of the Visual Communications Department. Highlights of her time in administration include working with faculty to implement an Applied Learning graduation requirement, spearheading the College's successful Carnegie Classification for Community Engagement award, and supporting the development of the first fully online programs at FSC.


A staunch proponent for the arts across the campus, Professor Puff was the founding member of FSC's Public Art Committee and has long served on the Artists and Lecturers Program Board and the Writing in the Disciplines Committee. Her teaching is equally outstanding, earning her both the SUNY Chancellor's Award for Excellence in Teaching and the Farmingdale Foundation Award for Excellence in Teaching.

Professor Puff has also co-chaired the American Institute of Graphic Design's National Design Educators Steering Committee and served on the Cooper Hewitt, Smithsonian Design Museum Education Board.

She received her MFA in "Illustration as Visual Essay" from the School of Visual Arts in New York City in 2000 and earned two BAs, one in English and Communications and one in Illustration. She is a Full Professor of Visual Communications.

I'd like to extend my heartfelt congratulations, thanks, and praise to Murray, Vincent, Allison, and Don. Their accomplishments are only matched by their love for Farmingdale and we are proud to celebrate with them tonight.

2021 has been a remarkable year of achievement for the College. One of our many points of pride was published in *The Wall Street Journal's* examination of the ratio of student debt to post-graduate income. By this measure, a Farmingdale degree in nursing offers our students an excellent return on investment, ranking in the top 25 percent of all U.S. programs. Among the other Farmingdale programs recognized were our business management and marketing programs (tied for first

place) and the computer programming and electrical engineering technology programs, which were each in the top five for return on investment. FSC keeps student debt to a minimum by keeping tuition low and providing scholarship aid. We can't do that without our alumni and friends. Your generous giving helps make this possible. The critical dollars raised tonight will have a far-reaching impact on students, faculty, staff, and the campus itself.

The Farmingdale Fund—which helps to fill the gap between tuition income and the actual cost of educating each student—provides flexible, unrestricted support that allows the College to respond nimbly to ever-changing needs. Faculty innovation and scholarship keeps our academic environment thriving. Providing access to students with financial need ensures that those who wish to be a part of our community can do so without hardship. All gifts, no matter the size, help the College serve as an engine of opportunity for our graduates. Our alumni go on to find meaningful and fulfilling careers, with early career earnings ranking among the top 2% in the nation (CollegeNet 2019) improving their social mobility without the burden of serious debt.
